





Scajaquada Creek is one of the most polluted, inaccessible and impaired waterways in New York State

Our community has a **once in a generation opportunity** to address and remedy the problems that affect Scajaquada Creek and **transform the Scajaquada Corridor into a destination embraced by Buffalo's Blue Economy.** Waterkeeper has done this once before, through our international award-winning work restoring the Buffalo River, but a key piece to success is community support and investment.

Scajaquada September is month-long campaign dedicated to raising awareness to the many challenges and opportunities surrounding Scajaquada Creek while raising funds to further Buffalo Niagara Waterkeeper's vision for a restored Scajaquada.

The month will begin with a press event and cleanup along Scajaquada Creek. Virtual engagements and education will take place throughout the month. The 3rd annual 'Scajaquada Scavenger Hunt' fundraiser expects dozens of teams to explore the Scajaquada Creek Corridor, solving clues and completing activities while engaging with the environment and nearby attractions and businesses, culminating in a post-hunt celebration.
