Before the Solo Sweep

- Sign the Solo Sweep Pledge by scanning the QR code & determine your Solo Sweep location. Check out our website for previous locations <https://bnwaterkeeper.org/cleanups/>
- Gather your supplies. I.e. gloves, garbage bags, trash grabber. & Download the Clean Swell App.
- Click “Start” under Start a New Cleanup option.
- Fill out information page- Group name should be “BNW, Solo Sweep Location” ex: BNW Gratwick Park

During the Solo Sweep

- Tap the icons in Clean Swell to record what you are finding. (Paper data sheets can be downloaded from the Solo Sweep Page)
- Take photos! (With your group, action shots or of your trash pile). We encourage you to post your photos and tag @bnwaterkeeper using hashtags: #bnwaterkeeper #bnwsolosweep

- Click “Finish this Cleanup” on the Clean Swell App.
