

## Welcome to **Emerald Evening**



On behalf of all of us at Buffalo Niagara Waterkeeper, we are thrilled to welcome you to Emerald Evening!

Thirty-five years ago, Buffalo's waterfront was highly polluted, declared biologically dead and labeled as one of 40 Great Lakes Areas of Concern by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The city's economy was struggling, buildings were abandoned, and people were leaving our community in droves. However, during this time a small group of concerned citizens who loved their community and envisioned a cleaner and more accessible waterfront banded together to form the volunteer group, Friends of the Buffalo River. It was a watershed moment.

Thirty-five years later, from the early leadership and advocacy of the "Friends" to Buffalo Niagara Waterkeeper (BNW), that dream is being realized. After massive efforts on the part of BNW and its partners to clean up the Buffalo River and restore the habitats, shorelines and access points, Buffalo now sits on a vibrant, activated and healthier waterfront. Cleaning up our waterway was the spark Buffalo's economy needed to turn from Rust to Blue™, and with it, a city came back to life. BNW has been recognized internationally for this historic and collaborative transformation, but we know we couldn't do it without this community.

#### New York Is A Great Lakes State

Our freshwater coastal environments are increasingly vulnerable as climate change causes declining ice coverage and increased frequency of severe storms, resulting in negative impacts on the water quality and the surrounding ecosystems.

As a state with not just one, but two
Great Lake shorelines, we are a
dedicated guardian for the protection of
the entire Great Lakes which provides
drinking water, recreational opportunities,
and unique and critical freshwater
habitats found in few places on the
planet.

The entire Great Lakes basin, including Western New York, is connected to the ocean. Lake Superior, Michigan, and Huron drain into Lake Erie, flow over Niagara Falls and into Lake Ontario and then onward until finally reaching the Atlantic Ocean.

Buffalo Niagara Waterkeeper's advocacy mission is to work with partners, municipalities, and elected official to ensure the health and protection of New York State's Great Lakes and shoreline ecosystems.

#### Brian Higgins

Lifetime Achievement Recognition

It didn't take much to recruit Brian to join the Friends of the Buffalo River – the precursor to Buffalo Niagara
Waterkeeper – in 1989 as a founding board member. A member of the Buffalo Common Council representing
South Buffalo, Brian instinctively understood the potential that the environmental restoration of the Buffalo River and the city's waterfront would have towards revitalizing the community.



From day one, Brian was active in the group, helping organize meetings, joining clean up events, and advocating for improvements along the waterfront. His participation and support provided the Friends group with the prestige it needed to grow and advance its work while building and cultivating relationships with communities along the Buffalo River. As Brian moved on to the New York State Assembly and then to Congress, he staunchly advocated for federal and state dollars to support waterfront revitalization.

For over 19 years, Brian served as a member of Congress, maintaining a focus on targeted initiatives which addressed the needs and leveraged the strengths unique to the Western New York community. His leadership secured a \$279 million federal relicensing settlement that has made redevelopment of Buffalo's waterfront possible. Brian's work on the House of Representatives Budget and Ways and Means Committees saw cancer research and infrastructure projects receive a major boost in federal investments. As a member of the Foreign Affairs and Homeland Security Committees. Brian participated in high level international discussion during his travels to Ireland, Iraq, Afghanistan, Sudan, Israel, Russia and two dozen additional countries around the world.

A member of the Congressional Arts Caucus and the author of federal Historic Tax Credit legislation, Brian has long recognized the social and economic value of investments in the environment, preservation, and culture. He now serves as President & CEO of Shea's Performing Arts Center, where he aims to position the three-theatre campus to sustain and grow its century-long tradition of delivering exceptional experiences and top performances to theatre goers while preserving the institution's historic character and building on the theatre's foundational standing in WNY.

Brian started off as a close friend, and Buffalo Niagara Waterkeeper has been honored to maintain that friendship over the decades.

#### Deb Gondek

For the past nine years, Deb has served on Buffalo Niagara Waterkeeper's Board of Directors. She was board chair from 2018 to 2020 and actively participated on several committees during her tenure. Deb's work with Waterkeeper gave her a new appreciation for the value of local waterways - the Niagara River, Great Lakes and all the creeks and streams within our watershed. She is a lifelong learner and one of her favorite parts of board meetings included staff presentations on current Waterkeeper projects.



Deb retired from Rich Products in 2017, where she worked for 17 years. Prior to that, she held positions in a variety of industries – including medical, banking, and real estate. During the first half of her career at Rich's, Deb was Director of Communication. In 2008, she was named the company's first Director of Sustainability. In this role, she collaborated with suppliers, customers, and associates at manufacturing facilities around the world to determine which aspects of their business contributed most to climate change. Subsequently, Deb developed an overall strategy to prioritize efforts and align company goals to reduce emissions, conserve water, minimize waste, and sustainably source ingredients. These initiatives improved corporate sustainability at Rich Products as well as saved the company millions of dollars annually.

In 2021, Deb became a member of the North Tonawanda Climate Smart Communities Task Force, a New York State program that helps local governments take action to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and adapt to a changing climate. In addition, Deb is a LEED (Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design) accredited professional, first applying green building principles in the corporate world, and recently expanding to government and communities.

In her free time, Deb enjoys biking, skiing, and early morning workouts with the November Project group. She finds every opportunity to be outdoors with her two grandsons and treasures time spent relaxing along Lake Erie's shoreline with her husband, Mike, and their family in Crystal Beach, Ontario.

Even though she is no longer on the board, we can always count on Deb to be a Waterkeeper supporter and to still be out there cleaning up the community, logging data and advocating for all of our water.
